



OFF-LICENCE

Section 17 to 20, and 64 Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

PURSUANT to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act), **MATAWHERO WINES LIMITED** (the licensee) is authorised to sell and supply alcohol on the premises situated at **189 Riverpoint Road, Gisborne**, and known as "**Matawhero Wines**", to **any person for consumption off the premises** and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises.

The licensee is also authorised to sell alcohol on or from the premises and deliver it somewhere else.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

Conditions

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

1. No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Christmas Day, or before 1pm on Anzac Day
2. No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Easter Sunday unless the alcohol is grape or fruit or vegetable wine made on the premises or from grapes or fruit harvested from land on which the premises are situated.
3. Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:

Monday to Sunday 9:00am to 6:00pm

4. A copy of the licence must be displayed at any principal entrance.
5. The whole of the licensed premises (the cellar door) is designated as **undesigned**.
6. Signs must be displayed at every point of sale detailing the statutory restriction on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.
7. In the case of remote sales; the licensee must ensure that the requirements of section 59 of the Act are met at all times.
8. Drinking water must be freely available to customers, while alcohol is being supplied free as a sample on the premises.

This licence is assessed as an Off-Licence, Winery Cellar Door, and the fee payable was \$368.00.

Duration

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force

1. Either
 - i. Until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - ii. If it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 12 months after the day it was issued; but
2. If an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, either
 - I. Until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - II. If it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 4 years after the day it was issued.

This licence expires on **12 February 2027**
